



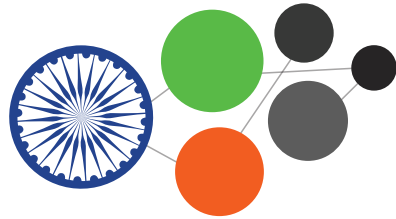

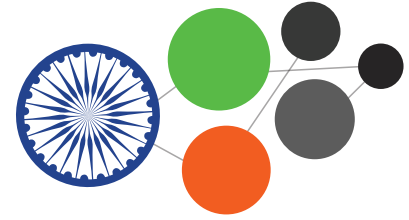

SERVICES SECTOR IN INDIA

India, the second fastest growing services sector in the world

- Services Sector contributes 57% to India's GDP.
- Share in employment is 26.8% in 2011-2012.
- Contributes 25% to total trade.
- Share of 40% in exports and 20% in imports.
- Accounts for 50% of FDI into the country. Second most attractive FDI destination in the services sector.
- Major Services Sectors:
 - Tourism – foreign exchange earnings are USD 16 billion in 2011
 - IT BPM – revenue is USD 118 billion in 2014
 - Media and Entertainment – market size of USD 14.93 billion in 2013
 - Education – market size of USD 62.34 billion in 2014
